PE KIT

On the day your child has PE, they must come to school in their PE kit. Black shorts and white t-shirt for warm weather.

Sensible PE shoes or sandals. They will stay in their PE kit for the full day.

COLD WEATHER

For those days when PE will be outside in colder weather, children can come to school wearing a **plain black or navy blue** tracksuit / jogging suit. No football/rugby kits or coloured tracksuits / jogging suits.



OUTDOOR PE

To reduce the risk of Covid transmission, most of your child's PE lessons will be held outside where it is well ventilated.

Jewellery

Can we please remind you that only small stud earrings are permitted for safety reasons—hoops or dangly earrings are not permitted.

As PE is a compulsory part of the curriculum, earrings must be removed on PE days.
