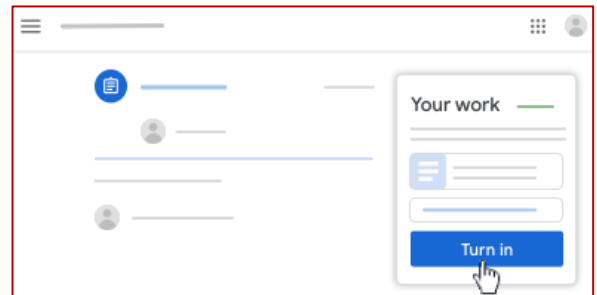
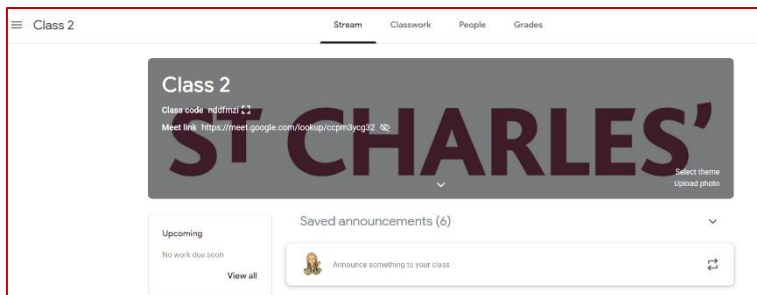
All activities will be uploaded via your child's Google Classroom, if you are unable to access these resources they will be printed on a weekly basis and will be available for collection by contacting the school office. When collecting work, please bring any completed work from the previous week.

Our core offer, outlined below, will be supplemented by the teacher to meet the needs of the children within the classes. All children should access their Google Classroom by 9:00am to see their daily activities and timetable of lessons.

Why Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is a web based program that works on a wide variety of devices, including smart phones, Chromebooks, ipads/tablets and even games consoles connected to the internet.

Work will be uploaded using editable Google documents that should be 'Turned in' when completed. You are able to add attachments and upload photos and videos to these documents to show what your children have been learning.

Foundation Stage

As a Foundation Stage Unit, we will offer a range of activities to support your children achieve throughout the curriculum. At times the activities will be for all the children and other activities will be specifically for children in FS1 or FS2.


Foundation Stage 2	
 Check-in	Regular Check-ins with class teacher
 Phonics	Daily Activities with a video for families to access to support learning at home.
 Maths	Daily Activities with a video for families to access to support learning at home.
Physical Development	Daily Activities available
Story Time	Video of recorded story time or a link to an author/actor reading a story uploaded to Google Classroom for children to listen to and watch . 
RE	Two weekly Activity uploaded to Google Classroom 
Jigsaw (PSHE)	Weekly Activity uploaded to Google Classroom
Wider Curriculum	Topic Activities uploaded to Google Classroom for children to access throughout the week.
Foundation 1	Foundation 1 will have a smaller selection of the above activities daily. These rotated every week.
