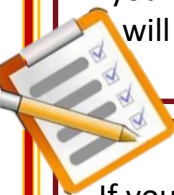

Morning Registration

8:45

School begins prompt at 8:45am and finishes at 3:15pm!

If your child arrives after 9:00am they will need to be registered at the Office.



Medical and Dental Appointments

Parents/carers are asked to inform the office before an appointment. Medical or Dental appointments can only be counted as an authorised absence when evidence is shown.



Absence

If your child cannot attend school because they are unwell please inform the Office by 8:50am on the first day of absence and **every day thereafter until they return**. Not providing a reason will result in an unauthorised mark and an accumulation of absences within a term may result in a Penalty Notice fine.



Diarrhoea and/or vomiting 48 hours

If your child has an upset tummy he/she can return to school once they have been symptom-clear for **48** hours.

Holidays during Term Time

Permission for leave of absence in term time is only granted under exceptional circumstances.

If you want to take your child out of school during term time, then you must complete an application form available from the office for consideration by the Head of School. Unauthorised leave of absence may lead to you receiving a **Penalty Notice fine**.



ParentPay Payment Reminders

Please keep your ParentPay account in credit.

If your account has an outstanding balance for school lunches **over £5.00** then we would ask that you provide a packed lunch until the outstanding balance is paid in full.

If you have an outstanding balance for Breakfast club or an after school club then your child(ren) will not be permitted to attend further sessions until the outstanding balance is paid in full.

After May half term if you require your child(ren) to attend either Breakfast or an after-school club. Payment for these services must be made in advance. Breakfast club costs £1.00 per child per day and an after school club is 50p per child per session. Sessions for after school clubs are normally offered on a termly basis.

Once payment has been made, your child(ren) will be allocated a place in the respective club and you will receive confirmation of this.
