
World Book Day Thursday 4 March 2021

World Book Day is on **Thursday 4 March** this year and we will be basing our activities that day on a book called Knock Knock Superhero by Caryl Hart. World Book Day is all about celebrating a love of reading and at St Charles we encourage reading at every opportunity.

World Book Day is a chance to have fun and celebrate the joy of books. We encourage your child to dress up as their favourite super hero or favourite book character at home if you are learning from home or at school if your child comes to school. We do not want you to go out and buy a costume if you do not have one at home. Your child can make a mask or just dress up in their favourite clothes. Please do not feel that you have spend any money on a costume. Your child can also show or tell us about their favourite book or author if he/she wishes (on Google Meet or by chatting on Google Stream.) We have lots of exciting activities to share so please join in by accessing the work on Google Classroom or by using your paper packs. We look forward to seeing lots of photos of your costumes and work.

Your child will also receive a £1 voucher to spend on a book at selected retailers. Children who are currently educated at school will receive a book token from their teacher. Children working from home can come into school and collect a World Book Day Token or we can email you a link for you to download a digital book token which may need to be printed off depending on which shop you choose to redeem your voucher in.





Below are details of the books that your child is able to choose using the World Book Day Token.











