Maths

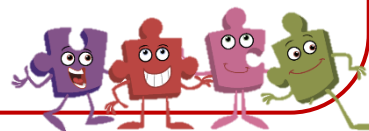
In Maths this week, we will be looking at negative numbers, adding and subtracting with numbers more than 4 digits as well as learning about factors, multiples and prime numbers.

This week we will be looking at the different types of words classes we use in our writing and their purpose e.g. nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbials.

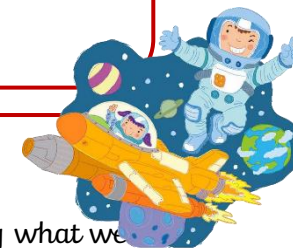
